The Service Industry captures accommodation, food and beverage, amusement and recreational, personal and household, government, and business services.


Between 2020 and 2024, annual average employment* increased by 8.9%, from 83,100 to 90,500 in the industry.




Hand injury rate decreased per cent from 1.47 to 1.15 since 2020


Lost-time Incidence Rate/100 Employees




Soft Tissue Incidence Rate/100 Employees
