Industry Highlights

The Fish Harvesting Industry captures the inshore and offshore harvesting of sea species, including aquaculture.

Between 2021 and 2025, annual average employment* decreased by 16.2%, from 3,700 to 3,100 in the industry.

Lost-time soft tissue injury rate decreased

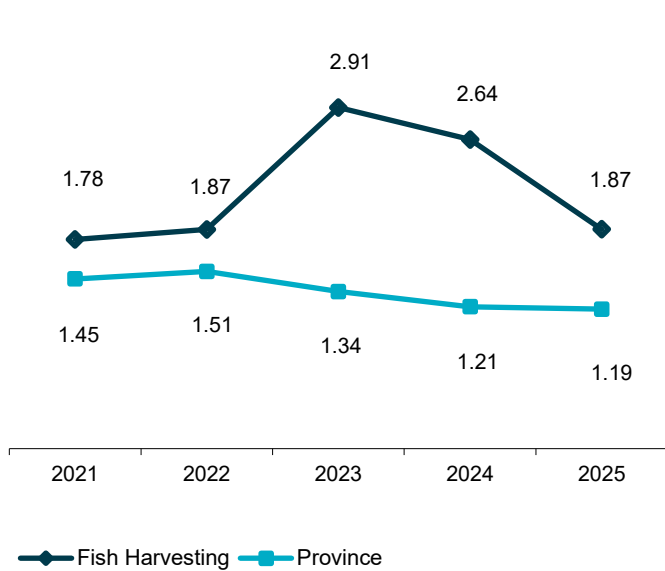

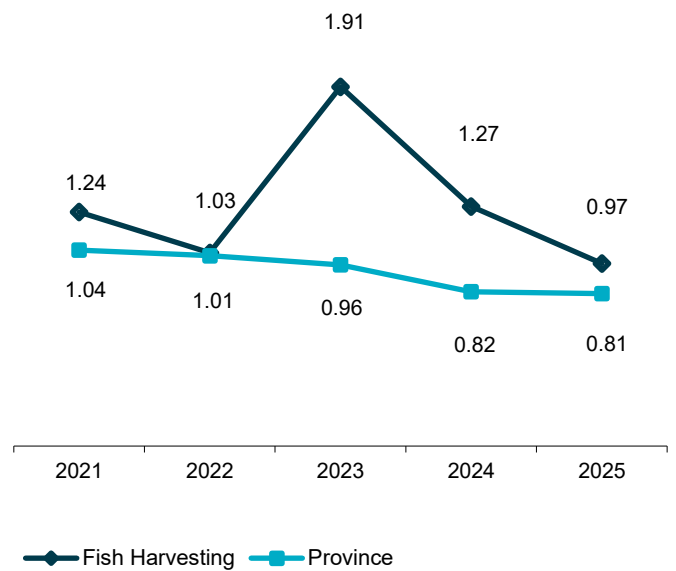

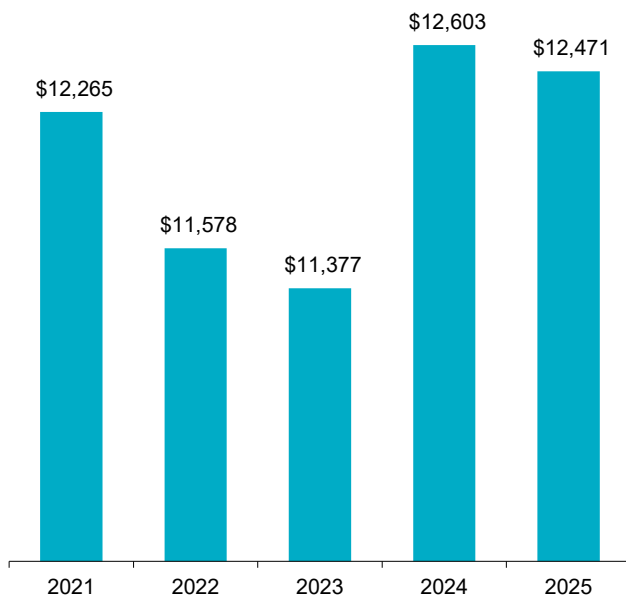
Lost-time Incidence Rate/100 Employees



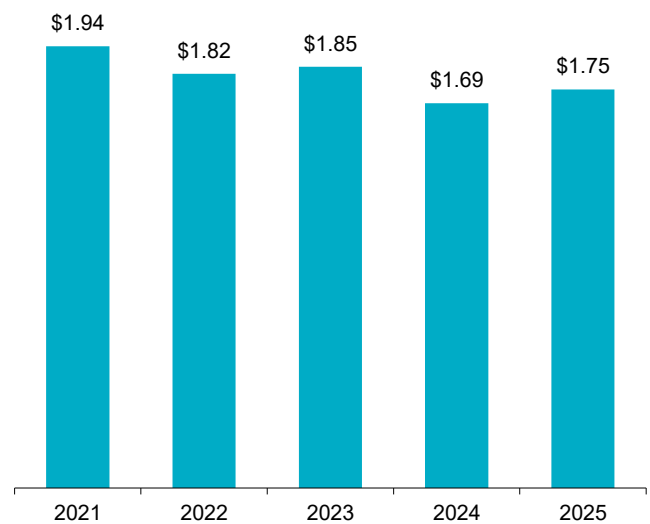
Soft Tissue Incidence Rate/100 Employees



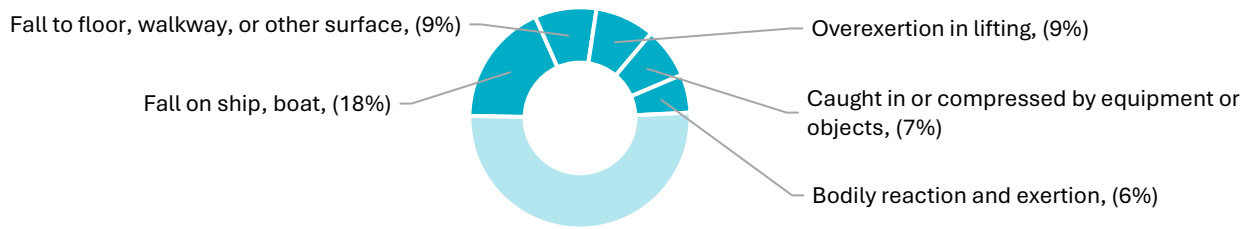
Total Claim Payments (\$,000)



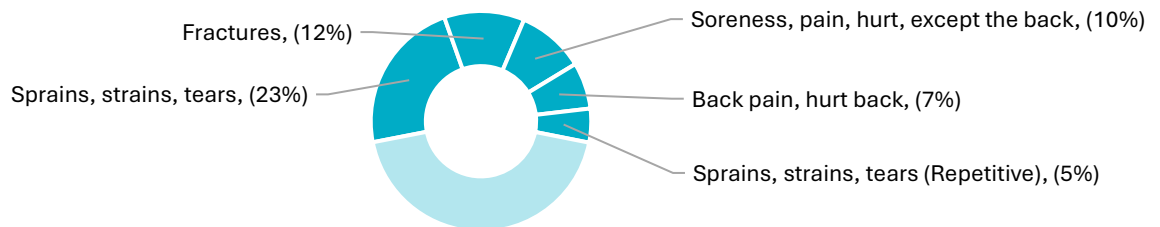
Average Assessment Rate



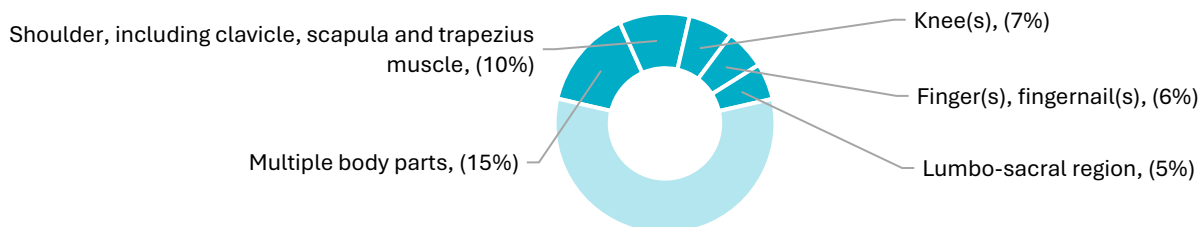
Lost-time claims by top five type of accidents, 2021–2025



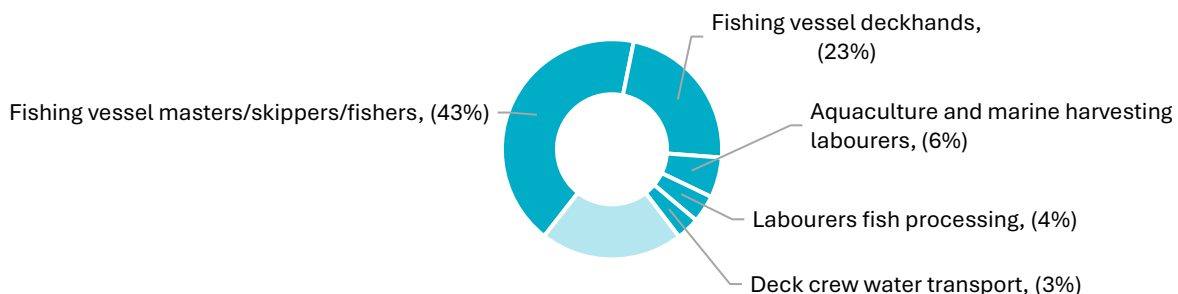
Lost-time claims by top five nature of injuries, 2021-2025
