The Manufacturing Industry captures manufacturing, processing, and packaging of items such as food products, beverages, plastics, clothing, furniture, household products, metal products, machinery, equipment, concrete products and petroleum.

Between 2021 and 2025, annual average employment* remained steady at 6,400 in the industry.

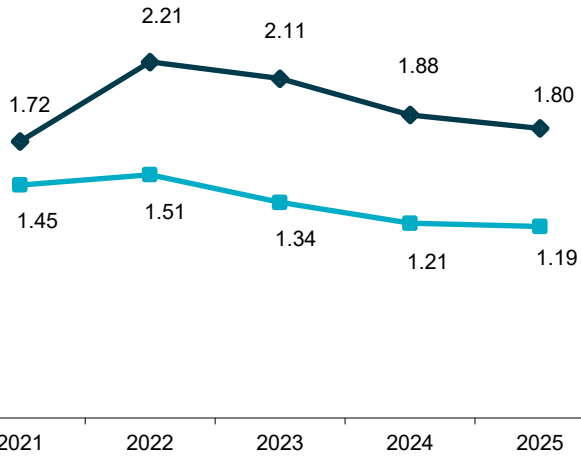

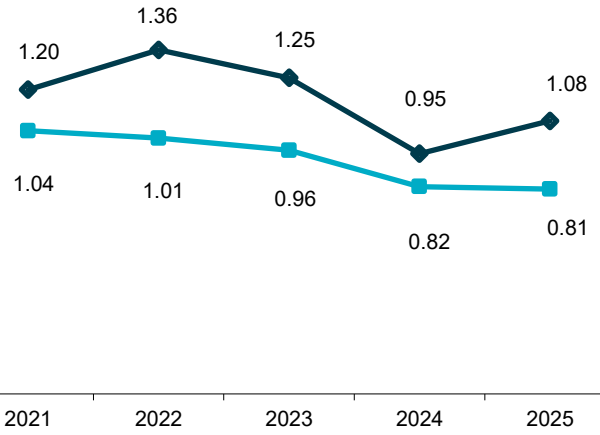

Lost-time Incidence Rate/100 Employees



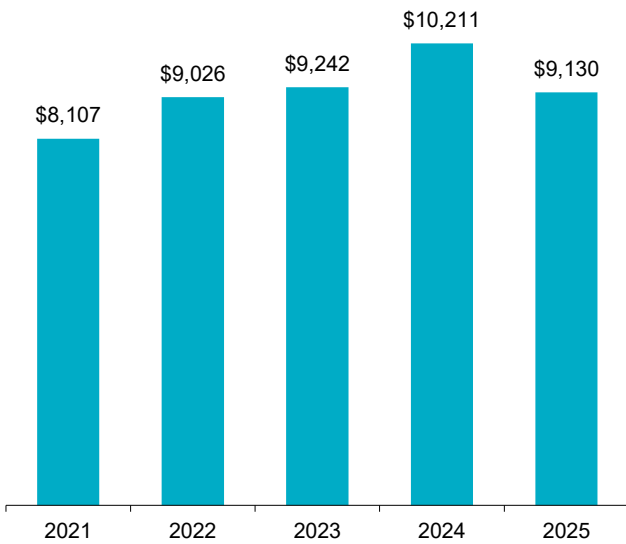

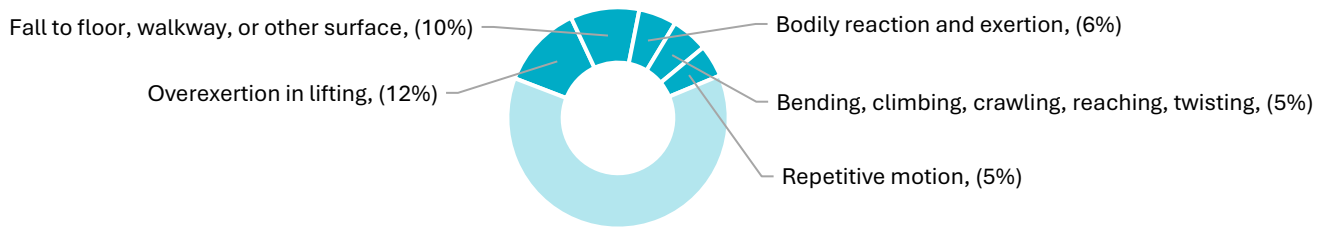

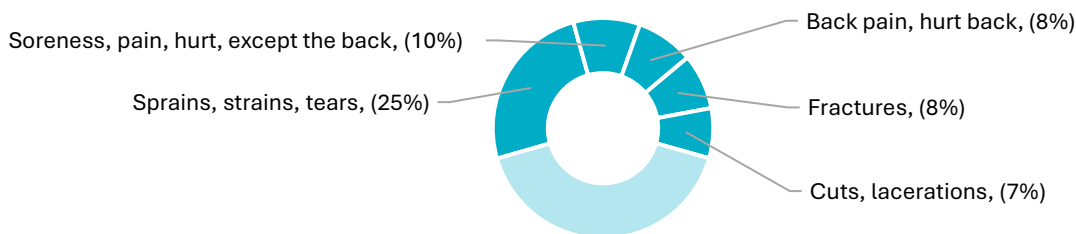

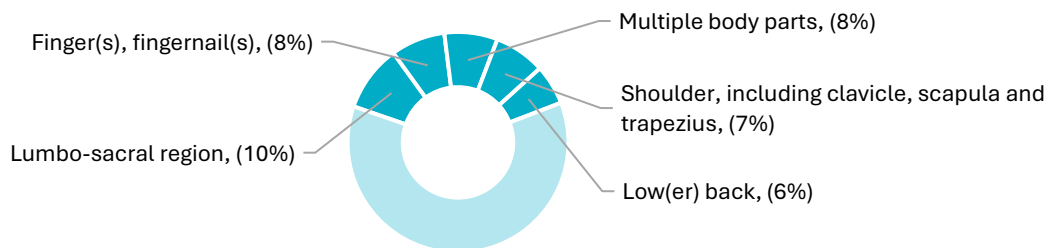
Lost-time claims by top five type of accidents, 2021–2025
