

A hearing loss-related claim is a claim that results in deafness, hearing loss or impairment due to employment.


Hearing loss-related claims by age group



Between 2017 and 2021, 4 out of every 100 accepted claims were hearing loss-related. Approximately 51.3% of all occupational disease claims are hearing loss-related. Deafness, hearing loss or impairment is normally not instantaneous, but gradual.

Frequency of all hearing loss-related claims for workers for 2017-2021




Cost of hearing loss-related claims for workers 2017-2021
