

2022-14-T: Standing Offer for the Supply of Hearing Aid Batteries for Injured Workers

To All Bidders:

General:

- This addendum shall be read in conjunction with the original Tender documents.
- Where inconsistent with the above, this addendum shall govern.
- No consideration shall be allowed for increases (extras) to the Tender Price, or otherwise to modify the Tender Submission, due to any failure of the Vendors being familiar with this addendum.
- The Bidder should insert in the Bid Form the numbers of addenda received by her/him during the Tender period. This addendum forms an integral part of the Tender Submissions and is included therein.
- It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure all addenda have been received by the Bidder prior to Tender closing.

Scope of this Addendum:

- The following question was posed concerning fuel surcharges:
"Canada post charges a "fuel surcharge" on the Xpresspost shipping envelopes at time of purchase which fluctuates frequently and is not posted in advance. It is simply applied to the purchase at the time of purchase. Could this be expensed to WorkplaceNL at the time of billing on a cost recovery basis (no mark-up)."
- WorkplaceNL has provided the following response to this question to provide bidders with guidance for their bid submission:
"Bid pricing must include all current and any anticipated fees or expenses that may occur over the duration of the contract (ex. shipping fees, fuel surcharges, any other type of fee or cost associated with the provision of the tendered services, etc.). While some fees may fluctuate over the course of the contract, vendors should estimate a reasonable rate to cover fluctuations."
