
Young Workers



Industry Highlights


A young worker is defined as a person between the age of 15 and 24. They may be at higher risk of being injured due to lack of occupational health and safety knowledge and work experience. As a result, injuries often occur during the first few weeks on the job.

The number of young workers employed in the province fluctuates, with peak employment during the summer months. Between 2018 and 2022, young worker annual average employment* increased by 8.5%, from 27,200 to 29,500.
