To All Bidders:

Please note this scenario has been updated to correct the age of the client:

Scenario #1

Brad James is a 36-year old Paramedic with Central Health who was the victim of a horrific assault while responding to a call. As result of this incident, Brad suffered a broken elbow and right shoulder injury. He has also been diagnosed with PTSD as result of the events of that day. Brad has been off work now for 6 months, and his treating physician(s) are recommending a return to work as he has made some functional gains with his right shoulder and elbow injury. Brad's Psychologist has some major concerns with him returning to frontline, crisis response work- and notes that it is very unlikely that he will be able to work as a Paramedic again. He has recommended he pursue work in a different field.
